- 1. Pediatric primary care provider. Please understand that we are not your child's primary care provider. Parents must establish care with a general pediatrician ("Your Pediatrician") for their child prior to scheduling an appointment with our office, and are required to have had at least one appointment with Your Pediatrician prior to your first visit with us. Additionally, your child must continue to be seen by Your Pediatrician as his/her primary care provider throughout the entire period of time that we are also involved in his/her medical care. Parents are required to notify us immediately of any change in Your Pediatrician.
- 2. <u>Orders and authorizations for tests/prescriptions</u>. Parents must obtain all lab orders, prescription refills, and authorizations for services from Your Pediatrician.
- 3. <u>Immunizations</u>: Parents must agree for their child to receive immunizations (vaccines) in accordance with the schedule for age recommended for the Centers for Disease Control. This will require verbal attestation at the time of scheduling. Avoidance of immunizations, absent a legally recognized exemption, will disqualify your child from participating in our practice.
